The Future of British Foreign Policy -

Christopher Hill 2019-03-12

Since 1945, Britain has had to cope with a slow descent from international primacy. The decline in global influence was intended to be offset by the United Kingdom's entry into Europe in 1975, with the result that national foreign policy came to rest on the two pillars of the Atlantic alliance and the Common Foreign and Security Policy of the EU. Yet, with Brexit, one of these pillars is now being removed, leaving Britain facing some serious challenges arising from the prospect of independence. As a result, there is the distinct possibility that both British and European foreign policies will end up worse off as the result of their divorce.
