Araruama - Ian Fraser 2018-11-28

Imagine que, ao nascer, você já saiba quantos anos viverá. Se viver muito, terá que enterrar todos aqueles que ama. Mas se for viver pouco, que escolha terá? O que você faz com o tempo que lhe é dado? Esse é o dilema dos habitantes de cada um dos sete povos de Araruama, a ambiciosa e envolvente proposta cosmogônica de Ian Fraser, este baiano de nome importado e sangue nativo, que se lançou, com método e estilo, ao desafio de criar um mundo. Um em que velhas Majés preveem o futuro, animais gigantes guardam as passagens, e anhangüeras, nem mortos nem vivos, assombrom as matas. E um mundo nascido da fusão cultural das três Américas pré-colombianas, onde, tal qual no famoso mapa do uruguaio Joaquín Torres Garcia, o nosso norte é o sul. Assim temos Apoema, a arqueira destinada a ver o futuro sem poder mudá-lo, nascida na fria, montanhosa e incaica aldeia de Ivituruí. Temos o jovem e reticente líder Kaluanã e seu amigo Obiru, um destinado a viver muito, o outro a viver pouco, vindos da aldeia de Otinga, de inspiração pataxó e tupinambá. O espirituoso Eçaí, com orelhas de jaguatirica que lhe dão audição aguçada, vem da cidade de Itaperuna, de inspiração asteca. Já o casal formado pelo gigantesco Batarra Cotuba e a feroz Izel Pachacutec vem de Buiagu, que funde a cultura maia com as cidades escavadas dos anasazi. O ágil Ook Séeb, com suas luvas de garras férreas, vem de Atibaia, de inspiração choctaw norte-americana, e Najoch Su'uk vem da pantaneira Tucuruí, de inspiração paiaguá. Mas enquanto os jovens percorrem a Ibi, a deusa mundo, no seu rito de passagem conhecido como Turunã, é na capital do continente, a cidade de Mboitatikal, de inspiração maia, que intrigas movidas por inveja, poder e ambições pessoais ameaçam mergulhar toda Ibi em guerra. O que Fraser vem construindo desde o primeiro volume da saga Araruama é nada menos que impressionante: com sua geografia reinventada, hierarquia social estruturada e religião própria, não raro a sensação é como se estivéssemos lendo Tolkien escrever o Apocalypso de Mel Gibson. A imagem que temos da América pré-colombiana e dos povos indígenas é, em grande parte, aquela que o conquistador europeu encontrou ao tempo da colonização. Mas sempre me perguntei: que narrativas épicas estariam vivendo esses povos, que monstros míticos ou deuses temperamentais habitariam a América enquanto os egípcios antigos povoavam o Nilo, enquanto gregos e troianos se enfrentavam? Quantas

ciudades míticas teriam, assim como Tróia, se perdido no tempo? O tempo, ou a deusa Monâ, que é elemento central dessa nova cosmogonia, fundamentada em Lévi-Strauss e inspirada em García Márquez, para atingir algo novo, inédito na literatura brasileira. Pois ao situar sua aventura em um tempo antes da História conhecida — "quando o tempo ainda era cru" — Fraser parte do folclórico para chegar no mitológico.
