His carefully structured presentation and evaluation of this politically encouraged research makes clear the need for scholars to approach such polemics as they would any new data, for there were discoveries of enduring significance that resulted from both movements. Indeed, Professor Wu approaches this recent scholarship with such subtle discernment that his work approaches an intellectual history of China. Completing this remarkable volume are documentary notes and a "Selected Bibliography," divided into nine parts that roughly follow the organization of the text, which together offer invaluable sources for further study and research.
