Growing scarcity of freshwater worldwide brings to light the need for sound water resource modeling and policy analysis. While a solid foundation has been established for many specific water management problems, combining those methods and principles in a unified framework remains an ongoing challenge. Socially efficient water use does not generally coincide with private decisions in the real world, however. Standard optimization frameworks are extended to allow for coordination costs, games and cooperation, and risk allocation. However, early attempts at

water trading have run into many obstacles.
