carved into woodblocks by wood engravers, and the blocks were used to create metal 'electrotypes' that would be used on the printing press. In 2014 Macmillan created a new set of reproductions from the original woodblocks, now held in the British Library. The printing has been done on a traditional 4-color proofing press, printing directly onto art-quality paper."
